Societies External Affiliations Policy

Section 1 - Definition:

- 1. The purpose of this document is to outline the processes and procedures that should be applied to all external affiliations of all Societies affiliated to Nottingham Trent Students' Union (NTSU).
- 2. External affiliations are defined as a formal relationship with an external organisation or body which is not that of Nottingham Trent Students' Union or Nottingham Trent University
- 3. A copy of this document will be available to any member of NTSU online at www.trentstudents.org or on request by emailing opportunities@su.ntu.ac.uk

Section 2 - Changes to this document:

4. Changes to this document can be made at an NTSU Executive Committee by simple majority vote.

Section 3 - Affiliations

- 5. Any external affiliation must be made in the name of the society and not that of Nottingham Trent Students' Union.
- 6. Societies who wish to affiliate with an external organisation must seek the approval of the VP Opportunities and/or Opportunities Manager. If permission has not been authorised the external affiliation will not be valid.
- 7. Requests must be submitted to VP Opportunities and/or Opportunities Manager via email to Opportunities@su.ntu.ac.uk. The VP Opportunities and/or Opportunities Manager will decide to either:
 - 7.1 Accept the external affiliation
 - 7.2 Accept the external affiliation with agreed amendments
 - 7.3 Decline the application and provide feedback on the decision

Section 4 - Limitations

- 8. All proposed external affiliations must not encourage behaviour likely to be deemed as misconduct as defined in the NTSU Members' Code of Conduct and Societies Code of Practice.
- 9. The proposed external affiliation must not contravene any relevant Union policy or procedure.

Section Five - Rulings

- 10. Should any external affiliation issues arise not specified in this document a decision on a course of action will be decided by the VP Opportunities and/or Opportunities Manager.
- 11. Should any matter in this document be subject to disagreement over interpretation the VP Opportunities and/or Opportunities Manager will decide on the final course of action.
