You will receive training for your roles but also have opportunities to attend further training sessions to develop your skills that may lie outside the remit of your role but will be useful for your employability.


## How?

If your application is shortlisted you will be invited for a short, informal interview on Wednesday 9th October. We will then contact you by Friday 11th October to let you know if you have been successful or not.

## Role description



**Chair** Brackenhurst Officer  
*Elected in the main NTSU Elections*

- To be the primary contact between NTU, NTSU and the campus committee
- To call and chair the committee meetings
- To set the committee meeting agendas
- To supervise and support the other campus committee officers, ensuring that tasks are deputised appropriately, and in the absence of an officer ensuring that their tasks are still completed
- To represent the Brackenhurst student voice at appropriate Union and University meetings
- To lead the direction of the campus committee, ensuring that the code of practice is followed at all times
