How?

Applications for the campus committee open at 9am on Monday 23rd September and close at midnight on Sunday 6th October. If your application is shortlisted you will be invited for a short, informal interview on Wednesday 9th October. We will then contact you by Friday 11th October to let you know if you have been successful or not.

You can apply for all roles, except the Chair, who is the Brackenhurst Officer by default. This role is elected in the main NTSU elections in March. Your role is for one academic year only. However, you are welcome to re-apply for another year!
