Job purpose	To assist in the efficient running of the Student Union Bars by dispensing drinks, promoting the business and upholding Licensing laws whilst maintaining excellent customer service

Main duties and responsibilities

1	To dispense drinks to customers to the standard specified and to abide by the liquor licensing laws at all times
2	To prepare the bar for service and maintain standards throughout the hours of service, making proper use of the bar equipment and provisions
3	To maintain standards of cleanliness and hygiene for all working and public areas in accordance with employers standards. Duties will include glass collection, emptying bins and other such duties that will help to ensure the safety of our customers
4	To use the electronic till following set procedures ensuring integrity of cash and stock at all times
5	Verify tickets & ID cards plus monitor the signing in of guests
6	To regularly inspect washroom areas and clear as necessary
7	To maintain personal standards such as uniform and equipment. The uniform provided / specified must be worn correctly at all times whilst on duty. The uniform must be clean and tidy.

To maintain customer awareness at all times and relay and problems to a line manager or other senior member of staff promptly.
 Engages in sustainable practices while in the workplace – accepts and follows sustainable office policies and procedures.

Secondary and other duties

1	Occasional cellar work where the post holder is expected to wear any provided PPE and to keep the cellar and stock areas in a safe and clean state at all times.
2	To monitor entrances and exits, ensuring they are kept clear at all times.
3	Working evenings, weekends and end of term events.
4	Tries new and sustainable practices: whenever possible, employee tries to reduce the negative environmental impact of their work – especially their waste and greenhouse gas emissions.

Standards

- The post holder will, at all times both professionally and personally, portray a positive image of NTSU
- The post holder will at all times uphold the values of NTSU and thereby demonstrate high standards of integrity, accountability, respect for others, courtesy and professionalism
