# What is Green Leaders?

## Green Leaders is an exciting sustainability scheme run in partnership with NTSU, NTU Sustainable Development Team and UPP.

It's designed to help students like you turn your sustainable ideas into realities as part of our [commitment to working towards a more sustainable future for our city and community](#).

The scheme is open to all students who have an idea for an environmental project, no matter how small. It simply has to positively impact your course, halls or campus. You can submit a project proposal as an individual student or as a team of up to four students.

If your project proposal is successful, there's up to £1000 worth of funding to make it happen up for grabs courtesy of NTU's Sustainable Development Team.

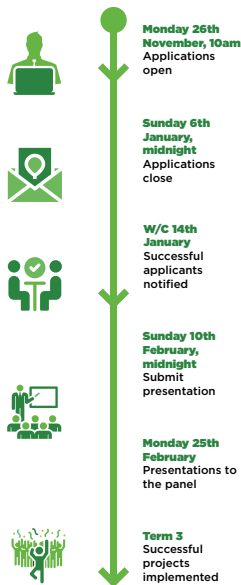
## Why should I get involved?

Becoming a Green Leader is an opportunity to collaborate with us on creating a more sustainable future. As well as having a positive impact on the environment, you will gain transferable skills like leadership, project planning and public speaking along the way that'll look great on your CV.

## How do I apply?

You can apply to take part in the scheme by [filling in this online form](#) and outlining your project. In order to give your submission the best chance of being shortlisted, try to include as much information as possible.

Once applications close (midnight Sunday 6th Jan 2019), all projects will be reviewed. Students whose projects are shortlisted will be notified via email and invited to present their proposal in person.





## If you're shortlisted...

You'll be asked to present your project in front of a panel of 'Green Dragons' (representatives from NTSU, NTU and UPP). They'll decide which projects to allocate the funding to.

The panel day itself will take place on Monday 25th February 2019 but you'll be notified well in advance and given time to plan and submit your presentation for feedback beforehand.

Your presentation should include the following:

### **Executive summary**

Provide an overview/abstract that concisely summarises your project.

### **The problem**

What is the problem you're addressing? Who will it benefit? Why is your project important?

### **The solution**

How does your project solve the problem? Include:

- An overview of your project and key factors involved
- The major milestone of your project
- A rough timeline
- Any potential challenges that could arise
- Sustainability considerations: outline how your project addresses sustainability issues

### **The budget**

Present a detailed and realistic breakdown of what the project will cost.

During your panel presentation, you will have access to PowerPoint and the internet but are welcome to present in any way you wish.
